Background

Hill's Angels share many things in common. Many of us run successful businesses, for example, and we feel "blessed". In addition, we all share a desire to "give back"...making the world a better place. This attitude of service springs from a spirit of gratitude.



The Angel Agriculture Project Defined

As a means of providing Hills Angels with an opportunity for service, Tom and his Hill's Angels will partner with Hill's Angel Jeffrey Hartman, and his faith-based non-profit, The CareLink Foundation, to provide microfinance capital to a group of ten disadvantaged women in Tegucigalpa Honduras. This funding will be used by the women to launch a cooperative and start a small greenhouse produce business; growing fruits and vegetables to be sold to local restaurants and grocery stores.

The Angel Agriculture Project will enable 10 families to break the cycle of poverty and change their lives and the trajectory of their community for years to come. Microfinance is transformative, sustainable, and can last for generations.

Fundraising Goal

We are seeking \$10,000 to launch this project. The funds will be used to build a greenhouse, purchase initial plants and seeds, and obtain tools and supplies. The business will be profitable almost immediately.
